

The 10 Nullifiers of ISLAM

1 – **Shirk** or **associating** others in worship with **Allaah**.

EVIDENCES: [QURAN 4:116], [QURAN 5:72]

2 – **Setting up intermediaries** between a person and Allah, calling unto them, asking intercession and seeking reliance with them.

EVIDENCES: [QURAN (39:3), (10:18), (6:51), (39:44), (34:22-23)]

3 – Whoever **does not regard the mushrikeen as kaafirs**, or doubts that they are kaafirs, or regards their way as correct, **is a kaafir**.

EVIDENCES: [QURAN (2:83), (4:155-157), (5:17), (5:73), (4:150-151), (9:31), (39:65), (5:72), (2:22), (14:30), (46:5-6), (4:36), (4:116), (42:11), (19:65), (18:26), (12:40)]

4 – Whoever **believes that anything other than the teaching of the Prophet (ﷺ) is more complete** than his teachings, or that the rulings of anyone else are better than his rulings – such as those who prefer the rule of false laws to his rulings – **is a kaafir**. EVIDENCES: [QURAN (40:12), (12:40), (95:8), (18:26), (5:50), (53:3-4), (4:65), (5:44)]

5 – Whoever **hates any part of that which the Prophet (ﷺ) brought**, even if he acts in accordance with it, **is a kaafir**. EVIDENCES: [QURAN 47:9]

6 – Whoever **makes fun of anything in the religion** of the Prophet (ﷺ) or **makes fun of any texts** that refer to rewards or punishments, **is a kaafir**. EVIDENCES: [QURAN 8:65-66]

7 – **Sihr (witchcraft)** – including **spells** to turn one person against another or to make someone love another. **Whoever does this or approves of it is a kaafir**. EVIDENCES: [QURAN 2:102]

8 – **Supporting the mushrikeen** and helping them against the Muslims. The one who does that, **is a kaafir**. EVIDENCES: [QURAN 5:51]

9 – Whoever believes that some **people are allowed to operate outside the law of Muhammad (ﷺ)** just as al-Khidr operated outside the law of Moosa, **is a kaafir** EVIDENCES: [QURAN (3:85), (6:153), (5:3)]

10 – **Turning away from the religion of Allaah**, not learning it and **not acting in accordance with it**. The one who does that, **is a kaafir**

EVIDENCES: [QURAN (32:22), (9:11), (19:59-60),
